### **SCOPE OF SERVICE**

#### In Home Parenting

**Service Area:** Butte County

**Program Philosophy:** To work in the home environment to support positive family functioning.

**Program Goal:** To assist youth and their families in meeting their mental health treatment goals by improving family functioning through parenting skills and support.

#### **Program Description:**

- **Service Type:** Parent education, case management, and supportive services.
- **Service Location:** Services are provided in the family's home and in the community.
- **Administrative Location:** 578 Rio Lindo, Chico CA 95926 Phone (530) 894-5933
- **Population Served:** Butte County Medi-Cal eligible school aged youth who exhibit mental health problems and their families.
- **Hours of Operation:** Monday thru Friday 8:00am to 5:00pm. In case of emergency, after hours or weekend/holidays, contact Butte County Behavioral Health crisis number at (530) 891-3277 or 1-800-371-4373.

**Service Abstract:** In Home Parenting is a collaboration between Youth for Change and Butte County Behavioral Health. Families receiving clinical services from Behavioral Health and its network providers (private nonprofit clinical programs) can receive In Home parent education and support provided by a highly trained Behavioral Health Counselors (BHC). Behavioral Health Counselors provide parent education utilizing a variety of curricula including Positive Discipline, Positive Parenting, Nurturing Parenting, and Love and Logic. Rehabilitation and case management services are also provided as needed. The BHC works in support of and in consultation with the primary clinician to assure continuity of care.

In Home service providers includes BHC's which receive specialized training and have specific experience in specialized parent education training/certification in the curricula mentioned above. Staff are supervised by a Licensed Clinical Social Worker.

**Referral, Transition and Discharge:** All referral, transition and discharge decisions are the responsibility of the services provider and applicable treatment team(s). Referrals will be made and documented throughout treatment, taking into account clients' and families' abilities and preferences. Transition planning will occur throughout the course of treatment, be discussed with clients and applicable treatment team(s), and be documented. Transition plan will include review of clients' wellbeing, gains achieved, and client and family strengths. Discharge paperwork and client history reports will be completed and reviewed at the end of treatment with clients and caretakers as available and appropriate.
