### **SCOPE OF SERVICE**

#### The FOCUS Wraparound Program (WRAP)

**Service Area:** Northern California Counties

**Program Philosophy:** The Wraparound Program is based on the family and community working together. The focus is the individual needs of one child, one family, one plan.

**Program Goal:** Wraparound is a community support system that builds on the strengths of the individuals within the family. The goal is to create a unified family plan for the future.

#### **Program Description:**

- **Service Type:** Family-centered, strength-based and needs driven.
- **Service Location:** Various locations that meet the needs of the family.
- **Administrative Location:** 7204 Skyway, Paradise, CA 95967. Phone: 530-877-1965
- **Population Served:** Families with children who have been placed, or at risk of placement in a group home or higher level of care, as identified by the Butte County Interagency Placement Unit (ISPU)
- **Hours of Operation:** 24 hours/day, 7 days/week. For emergencies, contact the Wrap on call pager at (530) 415-2171 or call 911.

**Service Abstract:** A child and family team is created. Needs are identified on an individual basis. Both formal and informal community resources are assessed to meet the family's needs and obtain their goals. Flexibility is a key component.

Each individual family is involved in deciding who is on their team. A family may consist of: immediate family, extended family, friends, neighbors, parent advocates, professionals, county agencies, and any community resource deemed necessary for a successful outcome. The family is an active participant in the team partnership. As the family's needs change, so may the team. This approach focuses on what is working with the family. It builds on individual's strengths, assets and skills. It pulls people and community together. A team is created that strives for trust, cooperation, self-worth, and family unity. Each family is in charge of their own goals and successes.

**Referral, Transition and Discharge:** All referral, transition and discharge decisions are the responsibility of the services provider and applicable treatment team(s). Referrals will be made and documented throughout treatment, taking into account clients' and families' abilities and preferences. Transition planning will occur throughout the course of treatment, be discussed with clients and applicable treatment team(s), and be documented. Transition plan will include review of clients' wellbeing, gains achieved, and client and family strengths. Discharge paperwork and client history reports will be completed and reviewed at the end of treatment with clients and caretakers as available and appropriate.
